Conferences & Meeting Facilities

Bright & Cheery with a View of the Lake

Severn Lodge is ideal for groups of up to 150 delegates or less, and exclusive use of the resort can be had for as few as 46 delegates. Our conference facilities are bright and cheery and have lots of windows with a view of our waterfront. The rooms can be equipped with all necessary audio visual equipment, and the resort offers a variety of business support services. Our 3 main meeting rooms are described below. In addition, there are several rooms/suites suitable for breakout or hospitality rooms.



Regatta Room

The Regatta Room derives its' name from the early days of summer regattas on Gloucester Pool, where it served as the meeting place for various events including the annual cottagers dance. Today, this beautiful waterfront room commands a breathtaking view of the many pine clad islands of Gloucester Pool, and can double as a meeting room or lakeside recreation room suitable for evening social gatherings. This cozy and warmly appointed room has three window walls overlooking the water, a large screen TV, a beautiful fieldstone fireplace, log beamed cathedral ceilings, piano, and comfortable seating. It is serviced by our resort wide wireless internet system.

Size -24' x 51'
Theatre, Boardroom, Classroom & Reception - up to 100 people



Lakefront Room

The Lakefront Room is located on the first level of the Main Lodge. This room is directly connected to our Dining Room and can be used either as a meeting room or part of the dining room for larger groups. Our Main Lodge is the oldest building on the property and dates to the mid-1800s', and the Lakefront Room was added in 1988. It has a vaulted ceiling with a windowed cupola at its peak. The room has three walls of windows affording an excellent view of our beach and waterfront, and is serviced by our resort wide wireless internet system.

Size $-27' \times 27'$ Theatre, Boardroom, Classroom & Reception – up to 65 people



Redfoot Room

Named after "Pappy Redfoot" a long time guest and native Canadian, the Redfoot Room is located just off the lobby on the second level of the Main Lodge. This room also has a beautiful view of the waterfront, an antique marble fireplace, and is suitable for small groups either as a main meeting Room or as a breakout room. It is serviced by our resort wide wireless internet system.

Size $-18' \times 22'$

Theatre, Boardroom, Classroom, Reception – up to 25 people

Georgian Room

This room with its' beautiful oak hard wood floor is located near the Main Lodge and is suitable for smaller groups either as a main meeting room or as a breakout room. It is serviced by our resort wide wireless internet system.

Size $-20' \times 20'$ Theatre, Boardroom & Classroom – up to 20 people

Dining at Severn Lodge

Over the years, we have gained a well–earned reputation for delicious foods, popular wines, and gracious country hospitality. All meals are served in our Main Lodge Dining Room where guests can enjoy a view of our waterfront. The Heritage Room with its' authentic log beamed ceiling rekindles memories of the early loggers that would have dined here in the mid 1800's, while the Lakefront Room with its soaring ceiling and window cupola is very light and airy. Both rooms have equally spectacular views.

Menu items are both regional and international, and are carefully selected to ensure a delightful variety of choices. They are meticulously prepared by our executive chef and his staff, and are served by our friendly and courteous staff. Attention is given to using fresh, high quality, and healthy ingredients. Guests can choose from a wine list that features a selection of the most popular international and domestic VQA wines.

Breakfast

Our breakfast buffet features a wide variety of choices and may include fresh-from-theoven baked goods, hot and cold cereals, fresh fruits and juices, pancakes or waffles, country fresh eggs, eggs Benedict or omelets, bacon or sausage, fresh hot coffee and more!

Lunch

Lunch is served in our Main Lodge Dining Room or in our screened in front porch. A luncheon menu or buffet will feature homemade soups, fresh green salads, entrees and desserts. Some days during the summer months, there is a poolside barbecue where guests can choose from a wide variety of luncheon items such as grilled chicken breasts, luncheon steaks, smoked pork chops, Oktoberfest sausage, and our good old traditional hamburgers and hot dogs. Also, there is a variety of salads, fresh fruits, and a selection of desserts.

Dinner

Dinner is also served in the Main Lodge Dining Room. Menus feature 4–5 carefully selected entrée choices that change daily. These entrees include a variety of top quality beef, poultry, and fish, along with a vegetarian selection. Included also is your choice of homemade soups and garden fresh salads, and of course, delectable desserts. We make every attempt to use fresh local ingredients in season and feature such local specialties as walleye and game meats.

Severn Lodge Allergy Protocol

We do our best to accommodate all food allergies and sensitivities. In doing so we have a multi-level method of communication that keeps guests, dining room and kitchen staff connected and aware of concerns. Comfort is in the communication.

We begin when you confirm your reservation, we make note of any allergies or concerns directly in the body of your booking. These notes are then communicated with our Dining Room Manager on check in day.

For your first meal in the dining room, please introduce yourself to the Dining Room Manager who in turn will take any further notes regarding your food sensitivity and share it with our Chef. If you wish, you are also more than welcome to speak with our Chef, simply mention it during your conversation with the Dining Room Manager and he'll connect everyone as soon as possible.

To aid in this communication, the Kitchen has a written detail board with all in house allergies and dietary concerns. The notes from your original reservation appear on the daily meal report that aids in Dining Room operations.

For the rest of your visit, we ask that you introduce yourself and your table allergy with your Server at <u>every</u> meal. Your server may change daily, and the introduction is an added level of communication that helps ensure we're all on the same page.
